Identity of Dagana Product



Dagana Dzongkhag Administration has developed a logo, which is intended to be used by the Dzongkhag as an identity mark for its local products. It is hoped that the use of logo will help in recognizing local produce in the market places and give due recognition to the local community for their product development initiatives. Further, it is expected to encourage local people to produce quality products and help build the image of the Dzongkhag through these unique high quality local products.

Description of the Logo:

1. Two Green Leaves: The first green leaf represents the quality of products, grown under natural conditions. The second green leaf represents the freshness of the products produced in a clean environment.
2. The Centre gold leaf represents the economical value of the products. The products will be made available at affordable prices, which will be based on the production cost of the particular product. The price will be reasonable to satisfy both the producers and consumers.
3. Leaves growing from the soil signifies the relationship of the products and their source. It also describes the originality of the products of Dagana Dzongkhag.
4. The white background represents the purity of the products.
5. The inner circle has 14 mini triangles and they represent the 14 Gewogs of Dagana.

Five value added products with the Dzongkhag logo were on sale at the World Soil Day in Dagapela and 110th National Day celebration in Drujeygang. The products include Mustard Oil, Flattened Corn (Tengma), Maize Flour, Kidney Beans and Green Grams and these have been identified for commercial production in Dagana Dzongkhag.

Hon'ble Secretary Dasho, Karma Yeshey visited Dagana Dzongkhag on 13 December 2017 to conduct a consultation meeting on 12th Five Year Plan. Dasho was accompanied by Planning Officers from Gross National Happiness Commission & Policy & Planning Division, MoE and an Engineer from the School Planning & Building Division.

The meeting was attended by Officiating Dzongdag, Dzongkhag Tshogdu Chairperson, Dzongkhag Planning Officer, Dzongkhag Engineer, Principals and DEOs of Dagana Dzongkhag. Dasho Dzongrab (Officiating Dzongdag) welcomed and thanked Hon'ble Secretary and his team for visiting Dagana to discuss the 12th FYP of the Education Sector. Hon'ble Secretary thanked the Dzongkhag Administrative officials for making time to attend the meeting.

MoE presented the key strategic plans for the 12th FYP of the Ministry of Education. The Chief DEO presented the 12th FYP for Dzongkhag Education Sector. Dasho and team expressed their satisfaction over the Dzongkhag 12th FYP. Few issues were deliberated extensively to reach a mutual agreement.

Later in the afternoon, Dasho and Team visited Gesarling Central School and met the staff and class 10 students. They also made a quick campus tour before leaving for Wangduephodrang in the evening.

44th Dzongkhag Education Conference

The 44th Dzongkhag Education Conference was held at Gesarling CS from 20th – 22nd November, 2017. The Theme of the conference was “Education for 21st Century Citizens”. The Principals of all the schools, two teachers from Namsheygang ECR & Dogak ECR, Vice Principal of Gesarling CS, Adm. Asst. of Dzongkhag Education Office, Chief DEO and two Dy. Chief DEOs attended the Conference.

The three days Conference discussed and addressed issues and challenges facing the Dzongkhag Education Sector, particularly to enhance the academic performance of the students in the upcoming years. Dasho Dzongdag, Gup and Lam of Gesarling Gewog attended the closing day on 22 November, 2017. Dasho Dzongdag said that knowing individual child’s background is important and asked Principals to maintain individual student profile.

The APA for schools was signed between Chief DEO and Principals in the presence of Dasho Dzongdag. Dasho reminded the Principals on their greater responsibility in ensuring the quality of education to the students. Dasho further shared insights into the resolutions passed by the conference to realize the vision and goal of the education sector. Dasho also advised the Principals to orient the staff, students and community on the *Driglam Namzha* after attending the Training on *Driglam Namzha* which was to follow the Conference on 23rd and 24th November, 2017. Dasho also made a campus tour and interacted with the students and small children.

Awareness on Fire Disaster

With the onset of winter the risk of fire disaster is very high. In order to prevent any fire disasters, the Dzongkhag Administration and RBP (Dagana and Dagapela) jointly conducted awareness and practical demonstration on usage of fire extinguisher for the public of Dagapela town on 17 October 2017. The public was advised to check the electric circuit from time to time and to switch off the electric appliances when away from home and not in use, and to close the regulator of LPG cylinder after use.

They were also advised to at least procure one fire extinguisher each which costs around Nu. 2500. Practical demonstration on how to operate the fire extinguisher was made.

On 23 October 2017, the Dzongkhag Administration and RBP jointly conducted practical demonstration on how to use the fire extinguishers for Dagana monks and Caretakers. They were also shared with information on various safety measures and interventions.

Awareness and practical demonstration on usage of fire extinguisher was also organized for Lhamoizingkha town on 28 October 2017. They were particularly advised on flood risks and safety measures. Lhamoizingkha has high risk of flood due to settlement in low lying areas.

Sensitization Program on Avian Influenza, Rabies & Farm Biosecurity

The Livestock Sector carried out awareness and sensitization program on Avian influenza, Rabies and Farm Animal Biosecurity in three Gewogs of Lhamoizingkha Dungkhag from 9-13 December 2017. The program was initiated considering the current scenario of subsistence livestock farming and with limited biosecurity implemented. The livestock disease outbreaks are on the rise and thus exert threat to human life, deviate social harmony and bring about high economic loss.

In total 139 people participated from Nichula, Lhamoizingkha and Karmaling Gewogs.

The Objectives of the Program were:

1. To control and prevent Rabies outbreaks in the Dzongkhag
2. To control and prevent highly pathogenic Avian Influenza outbreaks
3. To create awareness on the importance of Biosecurity, economic and social benefits
4. Overall "*Prevention is Better than Cure*"

The winter season being a high risk period for Avian Influenza (Bird Flu) outbreak, the Sector has carried out awareness program in Lhamoizingkha Dungkhag given the porous border with the Indian state of West Bengal and Assam.

The Sector also advised the public of three Gewogs that if they encounter any unusual poultry deaths in their area, they should call immediately toll free No. 124 national Centre for Animal Health (NCAH), Serbithang, Thimphu or 155 Bhutan Agriculture Food Regulatory Authority (BAFRA).

Health Screening and Awareness Camp

110th National day in Dagana Dzongkhag was celebrated in Drukjeygang Central School on 17 December 2017. The Health Staff of Drukjeygang BHU II organized a Health screening program to screen for Non Communicable Diseases (blood pressure, height & weight (BMI) and random blood sugar). They also provided related health education to the public on seven types of NCDs, namely cancer, heart disease, chronic lung disease, mental illness, chronic liver disease, diabetes & hypertension and its causes such as tobacco use/ smoking, harmful use of alcohol, physical inactivity and eating unhealthy diet. Out of 125 screened, 49 were found with high blood pressure, 52 overweight & 12 with high random blood sugar.

Health Services at Dagana Tshechu

During the five days of Dagana Tsechu, Daga BHU-I initiated to provide first aid services, condom distribution and screening of Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs) and STIs to the general public. Out of 143 people screened for NCDs, 45 were detected as overweight, 33 obesity, 20 Hypertension (new) and 3 diabetic. Other services like STIs screening for HIV, hepatitis and syphilis and first aid were also provided during the entire five days.
